Paul's Work for the Church

²⁴ I am glad when I suffer for you in my body, for I am

participating in the sufferings of Christ that continue for

his body, the church. ²⁵ God has given me the

responsibility of serving his church by proclaiming his

entire message to you.





Colossians 1:24-29

They wanted to know why Paul was imprisoned and treated so harshly for the sake of the Gospel.

1. Paul explains the joy in suffering, in his body for the progress of the Church. (vrs 24)







Colossians 1:24-29

Paul explains that God had given him this great responsibility, of participating in the sufferings of Christ, and for serving Christ's body, the Church, and proclaiming Christ's message. (vrs 25)





Colossians 1:24-29

Paul explains the Power and Importance of this Gospel ²⁶ This message was kept secret for centuries and

generations past, but now it has been revealed to God's people.

This message, this gospel, this good news, was kept in secret for centuries and past generations





Colossians 1:24-29

The Secret of God's Grace Towards the Gentiles

²⁷ For God wanted them to know that the riches and glory of Christ are for you Gentiles, too. And this is the secret: Christ lives in you. This gives you assurance of sharing his glory.

- 1 The Gospel is revealed by God Himself.
- 2 The riches of the glory of Christ are for the Gentiles too.
- 3 Christ lives in you.

4 This gives you an assurance of sharing in His glory





Colossians 1:24-29

The Disposition of Paul and his Co-workers

²⁸ So we <u>tell</u> others about Christ, <u>warning</u> everyone and <u>teaching</u> everyone with all the wisdom God has given us. We want to <u>present</u> them to God, perfect^[g] in their relationship to Christ.

- 1.We tell
- 2.We warn
- 3. We teach
- 4. We present

With all the wisdom God has given us, to present them perfect, in their relationship to Christ.

Paul's Recipe for Success

- ²⁹ That's why <u>I work</u> and <u>struggle so hard</u>, <u>depending on</u>
 <u>Christ's mighty power</u> that works within me.
 1.I work
- 2.1 struggle
- 3.I depend on Christ's mighty power

3. He ministers the word of Christ.

The False Teachers in Contrast

- Their motivation was power or money or something else
- Paul was led by God but they appointed themselves
- Paul's teachings was from God
- Their teaching are made up





1. The methods of false teachers are always the same

- Deny Christ
- Pervert true doctrine / teaching
- Lead people away from Christ
- 2. The gospel produces everything God intends for us
- 3. Suffering is a normal part of the Christian walk
