What is the Kingdom of God

- A King and Lord – a sovereign rule
- A Territory – a domain
- A constitution – a royal covenant
- A Citizenry – a community of subjects
- Law – acceptable principles
- Privileges – rights and benefits
- Code of Ethics – lifestyle and conduct
- Social culture – protocol and procedures
- A commonwealth – economic security

Can I go into my Mum's womb again!?

- Nicodemus was a Jewish Rabbi and leader
- Nicodemus acknowledges Jesus is sent from God
- Jesus recognises he must be born again!
- You cannot see the Kingdom of God
- Spiritual reality with physical consequences
- You cannot enter the Kingdom of God
- Nicodemus thought he was exempt!
- Entry is through Faith by Grace

I will pour out my spirit on all flesh

- Pentecost, also known as The Feast of Harvest or Feast of Weeks
- It was the day the Children of Israel received the commandments from God
- Pentecost was 50 days after Passover or 7 sabbaths (49) plus one day
- After the ascension, Jesus instructed them to wait for the promise
- 120 waited out of the initial hundreds
- We all want to change
- God's infilling took everyone by surprise


The Decision

- What will your decision be?


Revival
